While those appointments are without stated term, they do not provide a guarantee of salary from the University" (from the faculty handbook)
- Not tenured, but eligible for tenure: Professorial rank faculty who are not tenured but are eligible for tenure
- Not eligible for tenure: Includes all special instructional faculty and professorial faculty with "visiting", "clinical" or "professional practice" modifiers in their titles
